**COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING
PERMANENT AUTHORITY**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On August 6, 2003, Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi (Applicant), filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, in taxi service, between all points in Chaffee County, State of Colorado, and between said points, on the one hand, and all points in the State of Colorado, on the other hand.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on August 11, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on October 8, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a formal hearing.

4. The submitted information warrants the grant of the requested authority.
5. The present or future public convenience and necessity requires, or will require, the transportation service as requested.
6. Applicant is ready, willing, and able properly to perform the service as requested.
7. This application for permanent authority is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for October 8, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on September 24, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi, is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.
4. Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi, shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
5. Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi, shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi, shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi, may

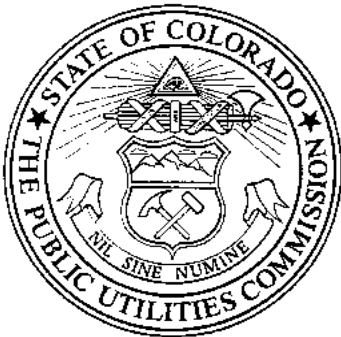
not begin operations until these requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission.

6. If Barry Bailey & Craig Dale, doing business as Valley Taxi, does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
