**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

1. On August 15, 2003, The GolfLine-Denver, LLC doing business as The GolfLine filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55719.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on August 25, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on October 27, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55719 is in the public interest.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. The hearing set for October 27, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on October 8, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by The GolfLine-Denver, LLC doing business as The GolfLine for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55719 is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55719 is authorized from March 1, 2003, through March 31, 2004.
5. On or before March 1, 2004, The GolfLine-Denver, LLC doing business as The GolfLine shall file a written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55719 or to extend the suspension period.
6. Prior to reinstatement, The GolfLine-Denver, LLC doing business as The GolfLine shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. The GolfLine-Denver, LLC, doing business as The GolfLine shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.

7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55719 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.

8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
