I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On August 14, 2003, Labor Limo Inc. filed an application seeking authority to

suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No.

55680.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on September 8, 2003. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on October 28, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the

requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55680 is in the public interest.

II. **ORDER**

A. **The Commission Orders That:**

- 1. The hearing set for October 28, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on October 8, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Labor Limo Inc. for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55680 is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55680 is authorized from April 9, 2003 through October 9, 2003.
- 5. Prior to reinstatement of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55680, Labor Limo Inc. shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Labor Limo Inc. shall also the appropriate vehicle identification fee.

- 6. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
