I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On August 22, 2003, Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc. (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.),

filed an application for approval to transfer Contract Carrier Permit No. B-8593 to Mill Creek

Management Co., LLC.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on September 8, 2003. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on November 10, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is non-contested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the

requested transfer.

- 5. The financial standing of Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, has been satisfactorily established.
- 6. Mill Creek Management, Co., LLC, is ready, willing, and able to properly perform the service as requested.
- 7. This application for permanent approval of the transfer of Contract Carrier Permit No. B-8593 is in the public interest.

## II. ORDER

## A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for November 10, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on October 15, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc., (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.), for approval to transfer Contract Carrier Permit No. B-8593, subject to encumbrances, if any, against the authority, to Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, is granted.
- 4. Mill Creek Management, Co., LLC, shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
- 5. Approval of the transfer of Contract Carrier Permit No. B-8593 is conditioned on the prior filing by Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc., (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.), of delinquent reports, if any, covering operations under the certificate up to the consummation of the transfer.

- 6. Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, shall also adopt the tariff of Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc., (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.), which shall become that of Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, until changed in accordance with the public utilities law. Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, shall pay the vehicle identification fee. Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc., (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.), shall file a terminating annual report from the first of January to the date of this Order. An acceptance of transfer signed by both Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc., (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.), and Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, shall be filed with the Commission. Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and it has received notice in writing from the Commission that it is in compliance and may begin service.
- 7. If Golf Hosts Resorts, Inc., (formerly known as Tamarron, Inc.), and Mill Creek Management Co., LLC, do not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the approval to transfer Contract Carrier Permit No. B-8593 shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

- 8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
