**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement and Findings of Fact**

1. On October 14, 2003, Qwest Communications Corporation (QCC) filed an application for partial waiver of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission's requirements found in Rule 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-1-40.2.3.1 and 4 CCR 723-1-44 and for shortened notice. QCC requested shortened notice for Advice Letter No. 019 on less than 30 days' notice and shortened notice for Promotional Letter Nos. 006 and 007 on less than 14 days' notice. All of these filings are regarding intraLATA and interLATA Part 3 services

2. As grounds for the application for waiver, QCC states that the restatement of the financial statements of QCC's parent Company, Qwest Communications International, Inc., is essentially complete. QCC would like to launch its intraLATA and InterLATA toll products in conjunction with a region wide initiative to residential and business customers. This initiative is being coordinated throughout Qwest Corporation's regions where § 271 approval has been granted.

3. On October 15, 2003, the Commission, on its own motion, construed the application as a motion for less-than-statutory notice and waived Rule 4 CCR 723-1-41.5.3.

**B. Discussion**

4. Now being duly advised in the matter, the Commission finds good cause has been stated and grants the application for waiver.

**II. ORDER**

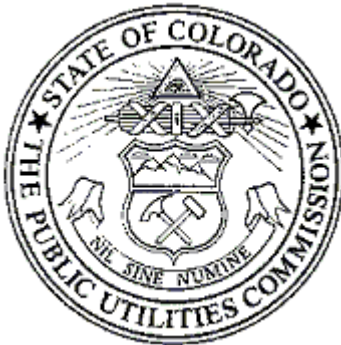
**A. The Commission Orders That:**
