**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

1. On September 24, 2003, Line Transit, L.P., filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, between all points within the Counties of Adams, and Jefferson, State of Colorado. This application is restricted to providing transportation services for Seniors' Resource Center, 3227 Chase Street, Denver, Colorado, 80212.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 6, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on December 8, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested authority.

5. A present and special need for the requested transportation service exists. A grant of the requested authority will not impair the efficient public service of any authorized common carrier providing a similar service.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. The hearing set for December 8, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on November 7, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. Line Transit, L.P., is granted authority to operate as a Class B contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a PERMIT.
4. Line Transit, L.P. , shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
5. Line Transit, L.P., shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Line Transit, L.P. , shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Line Transit, L.P., may not begin operations until it has met these requirements and notice in writing has been received from the Commission stating it is compliance and may begin service.
6. If Line Transit LP does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause

shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
