I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On October 16, 2003, Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., (Mobility Express), filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, in call-and-demand limousine service, between the Aventine Apartment Homes, 3257 South Parker Road, Aurora, Colorado, and the Fenton Place, Apartments, 7100 East Evans Avenue, Denver, Colorado, on the one hand, and all points within the State of Colorado, on the other hand.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 20, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on December 19, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested authority.

5. The present or future public convenience and necessity requires, or will require, the transportation service as requested.

6. Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., is ready, willing, and able to properly perform the service as requested.

7. This application for permanent authority is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for December 19, 2003, is vacated.

2. This application was deemed complete on November 24, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

3. Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.

4. Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.

5. Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Mobility Express

Transportation System, Inc., shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission stating it is compliance and may begin service.

6. If Mobility Express Transportation System, Inc., does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
