I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of motions filed by Kinder Morgan, Inc. (Kinder Morgan), to withdraw its Advice Letter Nos. 201 and 202, and tariff sheets filed in these dockets. Kinder Morgan filed its motions on December 10, 2003.

2. Kinder Morgan indicates that after several meetings and discussions with Commission Staff and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel (OCC) regarding these Advice Letters, it believes it would be more efficient and expedient to withdraw its present filings and prepare a new filing at a later date. Kinder Morgan indicates it intends to develop a new tariff based on input from Commission Staff and OCC.

3. Kinder Morgan states that no parties would be prejudiced by its withdrawal of Advice Letter Nos. 201 and 202 and the termination of these docket proceedings.

4. We find good cause exists to grant Kinder Morgan's motions. As a result we deny as moot, OCC's request for hearing regarding Advice Letter Nos. 201 and 202, filed on December 10, 2003.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

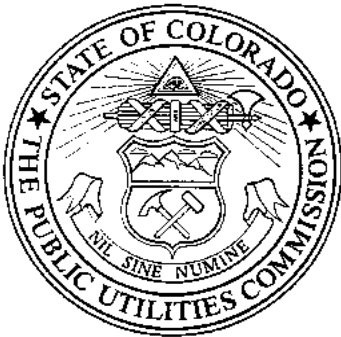
