I. STATEMENT

- 1. On January 10, 2003, Staff of the Public Utilities Commission (Staff) filed its Unopposed Motion to Vacate Hearing. By this motion Staff seeks to vacate the hearing in this matter currently scheduled for January 16, 2003. As grounds for the motion Staff states that it, Applicant City of Thornton (City), and Intervenor Union Pacific Railroad Company (Railroad) had been attempting to negotiate a settlement to this proceeding. However, in initial settlement discussions the City and the Railroad have agreed to investigation alternative crossing protection device configurations. This process will require a new design proposal, which will require at least 12 weeks to complete. After completion all parties will need an opportunity to review the design and further negotiate.
- 2. The Commission encourages negotiated settlements to contested proceedings. Therefore the motion will be granted. The parties are ordered to file a Joint Status Report no later than May 1, 2003.
