Trial Staff of the Commission ("Staff") and Ecstasy-N-Sunset Limousine ("Respondent") enter into this Stipulation and request that the Commission issue an order approving its terms as a complete resolution of all issues in this docket. In support of the Stipulation, Staff and Respondent state as follows:

1. On May 17, 2003, Civil Penalty Assessment Notice No. 28180-CPAN ("CPAN") was issued to Respondent by Commission Investigator John Opeka. Mr. Opeka issued the CPAN as the result of a complaint filed with the Commission and Mr. Opeka's subsequent investigation. A copy of the CPAN is attached as Appendix A, and by reference incorporated herein.

- 2. In the CPAN, Respondent was charged with one violation of Rule 9.1, of 4 CCR 723-33, External Markings.
- 3. Section 40-7-113(1)(g), C.R.S., and Rule 11.4 of 4 CCR 723-33, allows for a penalty of up to \$200.00 per violation. Rule 11.10.2, of 4 CCR 723-33, allows a fine to be tripled if a company has been issued civil penalties more than twice in the previous year. Respondent was issued CPANs for violations of Rule 9.1, of 4 CCR 723-33, External Markings on November 6, 2002 (See 27797-CPAN and Decision No. R02-1252). Staff sought maximum penalties in this case. The total amount of the CPAN is \$600.00.
- 4. For the purpose of resolving all issues in this docket, Staff and Respondent now desire to compromise and settle the charges contained in the CPAN. STAFF AND RESPONDENT HEREBY STIPULATE AND AGREE AS FOLLOWS:
- a. Respondent admits to all violations as contained in Civil Penalty Assessment No. 28180-CPAN.
- b. Respondent has removed all external markings from his vehicle.
- c. In consideration of Respondent's admissions in subparagraph (4)(a), above, and Respondent's cooperation detailed in paragraph (4)(b) above, Staff agrees to reduce the amount of the penalty from \$600.00 to \$300.00.
- d. **Payment.** Respondent agrees to pay to the Public Utilities Commission the amount of \$300.00 as payment in full for

the CPAN. Payment is to be made within ten days after the issuance of a final decision of the Commission approving this Stipulation. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that if the Respondent does not make the payment as agreed to herein, then (1) the Respondent's admissions in subparagraph (4) (a), above, shall constitute conclusive evidence that the violations occurred and that the fines therefore are justified, and (2) the Respondent shall be immediately liable for the full amount of the penalty, \$600.00.

- 5. In the event that this Stipulation is modified or not approved in its entirety, either Staff or Respondent, at that party's option, may withdraw from this Stipulation. In that event, Docket No. 03G-331EC shall be set for hearing.
- 6. The Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission and Respondent request that the presiding Administrative Law Judge accept this Stipulation in settlement of 28180-CPAN, issue an Order consistent with this Stipulation and its provisions, and close Docket No. 03G-331EC.
