I. **BY THE COMMISSION**

> Α. **Statement and Findings**

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of the application

filed by Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service or Company) on January 30, 2004

for Commission review of its electric commodity trading operations. This application was filed

pursuant to the Company's Phase I Rate Case Settlement (RCS) in Docket No. 02S-315EG.

2. At the Commissioners' Weekly Meeting on March 17, 2004, the Commission

deemed the application complete. In the application, Public Service proposes to change three

aspects of its electric commodity trading: changes to its Trading Rules (Attachment J to the

RCS), removal of those provisions in a footnote in the 2000 Trading Stipulation (Attachment H

to the RCS), and adoption of a new method for sharing net trading gains. Under the RCS, if the

Commission modifies the regulatory treatment of Public Service's electric commodity trading in

a way which is unacceptable to the Company, it retains the right to cease its trading operations

and change its energy cost recovery mechanism to a 100 percent pass-through.

3. Holy Cross Energy, the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel, and Staff of the

Colorado Public Utilities Commission have now intervened in this matter.

B. Conclusions

4. Based on the interventions filed in this docket and the significant regulatory

policies associated with the Company's electric commodity trading operations, the Commission

will set the application for hearing. The Commission will hear the case *en banc*.

5. A prehearing conference will be held at the date and time specified below. The

prehearing conference will deal with pending motions; discovery; the establishment of a

procedural schedule, including dates for prefiling of testimony and hearing dates; and any related

matters. Prior to the prehearing conference, the parties shall attempt to develop a mutually

agreeable procedural schedule.
