**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

1. On January 20, 2004, Thought Products, LLC., doing business as Compucab filed an application seeking approval to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55694.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on January 26, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on March 29, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested abandonment.

5. The application to abandon CPCN PUC No. 55694 is in the public interest.

**II. ORDER**

**A. The Commission Orders That**

1. The hearing set for March 29, 2004, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on March 24, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Thought Products. LLC., doing business as Compucab for approval to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55694 is granted.
4. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55694 is CANCELED.
