I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement

1. On April 30, 2004 Colorado Coach Transportation, LLC, (Colorado Coach) filed a

proposed time schedule change to become effective on June 1, 2004. Colorado Coach provides

scheduled service between points in the Denver Metro area and Black Hawk-Central City.

2. Colorado Coach proposes substantial changes that cancel all schedules operated in

the Denver Metro area by the previous owner Casino Coach. Colorado Coach has not posted the

change in it's terminal office or pick-up points of the carrier's extant schedules or in the motor

vehicles used in the scheduled service.

3. The Commission finds that notice was not posted in office, terminals, or vehicles

as required by 4 Code of Colorado Regulations 723-1.

- 1. The time schedule filed changes by Colorado Coach Transportation LLC to be effective on June 1, 2004 is rejected.
