I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On May 19, 2004, Alan Griffin and Wayne Groome doing business as Historical Trolley Tour filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55706S.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 1, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on August 10, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55706S is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

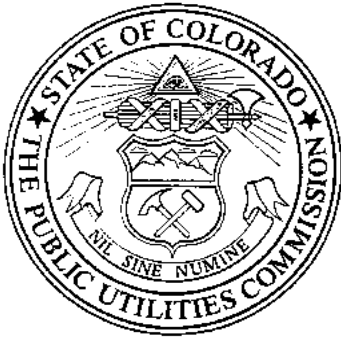
1. The hearing set for August 10, 2004, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on July 9, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Alan Griffin and Wayne Groome doing business as Historical Trolley Tour for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55706S is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55706S is authorized from May 15, 2004 through July 15, 2004.
5. Prior to reinstatement, Alan Griffin and Wayne Groome doing business as Historical Trolley Tour shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Alan Griffin and Wayne Groome doing business as Historical Trolley Tour shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
6. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55706S or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.

7. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

8. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
