I. **BY THE COMMISSION:**

> Α. **Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

1. On June 15, 2004, Mados Systems, Inc., doing business as Mados Transportation

& Personnel Services (Mados Transportation), filed an application for permanent authority to

extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9853 by eliminating Restrictions (5) and

(6) which read as follows: (5) To the use of vehicles with a seating capacity between 8 and 15

passengers, including the driver, except wheelchair accessible vehicles that, but for their

configuration to accommodate wheelchair passengers would have accommodated between 8 and

15 passengers, including the driver; and (6) To the use of a maximum of three vehicles.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 28, 2004. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on August 30, 2004.

- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested extension.
- 5. A present and special need for the requested transportation services exists. A grant of the requested authority will not impair the efficient public service of any authorized common carrier providing a similar service.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for August 30, 2004, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on August 3, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. Mados Transportation is authorized to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9853 as requested in this application.
- 4. The complete authority under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9853, as extended, shall be as set forth in the Appendix and this Order is a PERMIT.
- 5. Mados Transportation, as the holder of Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9853, shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
- 6. Mados Transportation shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Mados Transportation shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and appropriate annual vehicle identification fee. Mados Transportation

may not begin extended operations until these requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission stating that it is in compliance and may begin service.

- 7. If Mados Transportation does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to extend operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
- 8. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

- 9. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.

 - (B) Jefferson County Division of Human Services, 900 Jefferson County Parkway, Golden, Colorado 80401;
 - (C) City and County of Denver Department of Human Services, 1200 Federal Boulevard, Denver, Colorado 80204;
 - (D) Arapahoe County Transportation Services, 2009 W. Littleton Boulevard, Littleton, Colorado 80120; and
 - (E) Adams County Department of Social Services, 7190 Colorado Boulevard, Commerce City, Colorado 80022.
- (2) Against the transportation of passengers 17 years of age or younger;
- (3) Against any transportation service that originates or terminates at Denver International Airport;
- (4) Against any transportation service that originates or terminates at any hotel or motel;
