ORDER REJECTING ADVICE LETTER

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. On September 13, 2004, Cat Communications International, Inc. (Cat Communications), filed Advice Letter No. 4 and on September 15, 2004, Cat Communications filed 1st Amended Advice Letter No. 4 (attached as Exhibits 1 and 2). Cat Communications states that this filing is to introduce an unlimited long distance option to its local exchange tariff, Colorado PUC No. 1.

2. The tariff filing also contains three proposed new rates, identified as Network Charges on the tariff sheets, which neither of the Advice Letters reflected.

B. Findings of Fact

3. The proposed tariff sheets contain incorrect sheet numbers for the proposed offerings. The filing reflects that the proposed changes are on Sheet Nos. 53 and 54, when the correct ones are in fact, Sheet Nos. 54 and 55. The proposed additions of the three network charges were not stated in either of the Advice Letters and there is no description of them in the current tariff or either of the filings.

4. Cat Communications has neither responded to Commission Staff's request for clarification of the filing, nor filed a 2nd Amended Advice Letter No. 4 correcting the tariff Sheet Numbers and including a description of the proposed rates for the proposed Network Charges.

C. Conclusions

5. Being fully advised in the matter, the Commission rejects Advice Letter No. 4 and Amended Advice Letter No. 4 filed by Cat Communications.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. Advice Letter No. 4 and Amended Advice Letter No. 4 and the accompanying tariff sheets filed by Cat Communications International, Inc., on September 13 and 15, 2004 are rejected.

2. This Order is effective upon its Mailed Date.
