**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement**

1. On October 25, 2004, Vail Summit Resorts, Inc. doing business as Keystone Resort, Inc. (Keystone) filed an application for authority to publish Revised Pages Numbered 3 and 5 to Passenger Tariff Number 4 to become effective on less-than-statutory notice. Keystone provides scheduled passenger service between points in the Keystone Ski Resort area.

2. Keystone proposes a free ski shuttle between points within Keystone. The proposal will result in 100 percent decrease in the rate paid by the public.

3. In support of the application, Keystone states that the reduction will apply to all who ride the local scheduled ski shuttle regardless of whether or not the passengers stay in housing managed by Keystone or elsewhere. The change will facilitate skiers' transportation to and from the ski slope.

4. Rule 31(f)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1, allows an order authorizing carriers to change tariffs on less-than-statutory notice for good cause shown. Rule 31 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1 requires that rate change proposals must be accompanied by statements setting forth all the circumstance, conditions, and data relied upon in justification of the proposed changes.

5. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown for the approval of the proposed free service in Keystone Ski Resort as proposed on Revised Pages Numbered 3 and 5 to Passenger Tariff No. 4 and that the application should be granted.

**II. ORDER**

**A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. The application of Vail Summit Resorts, Inc. doing business as Keystone Resort, Inc., to publish Revised Pages Numbered 3 and 5 to Passenger Tariff No. 4 on less-than-statutory notice is granted.

2. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

3. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
