I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

- 1. On September 22, 2004, Care-4-U Transportation, Inc. (Care-4-u) filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 from September 25, 2004 through November 30, 2004.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 4, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on December 3, 2004.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 is in the public interest.

II. **ORDER**

A. **The Commission Orders That:**

- 1. The hearing set for December 3, 2004, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on November 10, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Care-4-U for authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 is authorized from September 25, 2004 through November 30, 2004.
- 5. Prior to reinstatement, Care-4-U shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Care-4-U shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
- 6. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

- 7. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
