SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On September 22, 2004, Care-4-U Transportation, Inc. (Care-4-u) filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 from September 25, 2004 through November 30, 2004.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 4, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on December 3, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for December 3, 2004, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on November 10, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Care-4-U for authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9835 is authorized from September 25, 2004 through November 30, 2004.
5. Prior to reinstatement, Care-4-U shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Care-4-U shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
6. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

7. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
