I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

1. The captioned application was filed with the Colorado Public Utilities

exceptions, and hearing dates.

6. In order to assist the ALJ, those involved are urged to confer prior to

commencement of the pre-hearing conference in an attempt to reach agreement on a procedural

schedule that will facilitate issuance of a final Commission decision in this matter within the

timeframe established by § 40-6-109.5 (2), C.R.S. (i.e., one that will result in completion of the

hearing no later than May 26, 2004).
