I. STATEMENT

1. The captioned case is currently scheduled for hearing on April 22 and 23, 2004.
2. On April 8, 2004, Staff of the Public Utilities Commission (Staff) filed a Motion for Summary Judgment and Request for Remedy.
3. The fourteen-day response time to Staff's motion runs until April 22, 2004, the first day of the scheduled hearing.

2. Responses to the motion, if any, are due no later than April 22, 2004.
