## I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

1. On April 12, 2004, Dolly's Mountain Shuttle (Applicant) filed a Motion to Amend Restriction of Authority No. 2. The restriction of authority as originally filed reads:

Against any transportation service that originates and terminates within a two-mile radius of the intersection of Main and Mill Streets in Aspen, Colorado.

2. Applicant requests to amend the application so that restriction no. 2 will read as follows:

Against any transportation service that originates and terminates within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Main and Mill Streets in Aspen, Colorado.

3. The amendment to restriction no. 2 is restrictive in nature, clearly stated, and enforceable. The Motion to Amend Restriction No. 2 is accepted.

## II. ORDER

### A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The motion of Dolly's Mountain Shuttle to amend restriction no. 2 as stated in paragraph number 2 above, is granted.
