**I. STATEMENT**

1. On May 10, 2004, Time Warner Telecom of Colorado, LLC (Time Warner), DIECA Communications, Inc., doing business as Covad Communications Company (Covad), and McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. (McLeodUSA), filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to and including May 21, 2004 to Respond to Joint Motion of Qwest Corporation and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel.

2. The current due date for responses is May 11, 2004.

3. On May 12, 2004, Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Staff) filed a motion for leave to late-file its response and opposition to Qwest Corporation's and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel's Joint Motion to Approve Settlement Agreement and Close Docket. Staff's Response in Opposition accompanies this motion and it was also filed on May 12, 2004.

4. Good cause having been shown by Time Warner, Covad, McLeodUSA, and Staff, the motions will be granted.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. It Is Ordered That:**

1. The Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Joint Motion of Qwest Corporation and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel to and including May 21, 2004 is granted.

2. The motion of the Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission for leave to late-file its response in opposition to Qwest Corporation's and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel's Joint Motion to Approve Settlement Agreement and Close Docket is granted.

3. All parties are granted an extension to file responses to and including May 21, 2004.

4. Response time is waived.

5. This Order is effective immediately.
