I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

- 1. On October 27, 2003, Cascade Village Condominium Association, Inc., and more than 25 individual customers of Mill Creek Water Sales & Distribution, LLC (Complainants), filed the Complaint which commenced this docket. On December 2, 2003, Mill Creek Water Sales & Distribution, LLC (Respondent), filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss. Staff of the Commission (Staff) has intervened. These are the only parties.
- 2. By Decision No. R04-0358-I the ALJ established a procedural schedule and hearing dates in this matter. Hearings are scheduled for June 29 and 30, 2004.

- 3. On June 3, 2004, counsel for Respondent met with the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to request orally that the hearing scheduled for June 29, 2004, be vacated and that the second day of the hearing be scheduled for July 15, 2004. Counsel for Complainants, who accompanied counsel for Respondent, informed the ALJ that Complainants do not object to this schedule change.¹ On June 7, 2004, counsel for Respondent informed the ALJ that Staff does not object to this schedule change.
- 4. The ALJ understands that the parties, their counsel, and their witnesses are available for hearing on June 30 and July 15, 2004.
- 5. Respondent stated good cause for the requested change in hearing date. As no party objects, no party will be prejudiced by granting the request. The request will be granted, and the hearing dates will be changed as requested.
 - 6. The request is unopposed. Response time to the request will be waived.
- 7. The procedural and other requirements established in prior Orders entered in this matter remain in effect. Only the hearing dates are changed.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The request to vacate the hearing date scheduled for June 29, 2004, is granted.
- 2. The hearing date scheduled for June 29, 2004, is vacated.
