**I. STATEMENT**

1. On April 27, 2004, Rye Telephone Company filed a Petition for Suspension of Wireline to Wireless Number Portability Obligations requesting that the Commission temporarily suspend its wireline to wireless local number portability (LNP) obligations to Commercial Mobile Radio Service providers in its Kim exchange until December 31, 2005. The request is made under the provisions of § 251(f)(2) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 251(f)(2).

2. Notice of the petition was given by the Commission. On May 10, 2004, WWC Holding Company, Inc., filed a Notice of Intervention.

3. By Decision No. C04-0589, mailed on June 3, 2004, the Commission among other things, referred this matter to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing.

4. It will be ordered that the parties of record confer with each other to determine available dates during the months of July and August, 2004 for the setting of this matter for hearing and also to develop a suggested procedural schedule.

**II. ORDER**

**A. It Is Ordered That:**

1. The parties of record shall confer in order to determine mutually acceptable hearing dates during the months of July and August, 2004 for the purpose of setting this matter for a hearing. The parties shall also develop a suggested procedural schedule, including dates for pre-filed testimony. The parties shall submit the suggested hearing date or dates and proposed procedural schedule in writing within ten days of the mailing date of this Order.

2. This Order is effective immediately.
