I. STATEMENT

1. On July 28, 2004, Town and Country Transportation Services, Inc. (Respondent), filed an Entry of Appearance and Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Exceptions to Decision No. R04-0771.

2. Counsel for Respondent states that he was engaged to represent Respondent on July 28, 2004. Counsel states that Respondent was delayed in seeking advice of counsel due to a family emergency and health problems. Counsel states that he needs time to review the record in this proceeding.

3. Counsel states that he has contacted Commission Staff (Staff), the Complainant in this case, and Staff has no objection to the motion.

4. Respondent requests a two-week extension of time until August 16, 2004 in which to file exceptions.

5. Good cause having been shown, the motion will be granted.
