I. STATEMENT

- 1. On May 18, 2004, Summit County Taxi Service, LLC (Summit County Taxi) filed proposed increased rates in Taxi Tariff Colorado PUC NO. 3 for the transportation of passengers between points in Summit County, Colorado to become effective on June 18, 2004.
- 2. On June 17, 2004, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission suspended the effective date for the tariff revisions proposed by Summit County Taxi and set the matter for hearing before an administrative law judge. *See*, Decision No. C04-0672. That decision also made the Staff of the Commission (Staff) a party to this proceeding and established a procedural schedule for filing witness lists and exhibits by the parties.
- 3. On September 24, 2004, the Staff filed a Motion to Permanently Suspend Tariff, to Close Docket and for Shortened Response Time (Motion). The Motion requests that the tariff revisions proposed in this proceeding be permanently suspended as a result of Summit County Taxi's failure to comply with the procedural requirements of Decision No. C04-0672. It also

requests that response time be shortened to October 4, 2004, in light of the rapidly approaching

hearing date.

4. Good grounds having been shown, the request to shorten the response time to the

Motion will be granted. Any desired response to the Motion shall be filed on or before

October 4, 2004.

1. Any desired response to the Motion to Permanently Suspend Tariff, to Close

Docket and for Shortened Response Time filed by the Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities

Commission shall be filed on or before October 4, 2004.
