I. STATEMENT

1. On October 22, 2004, South Park Telephone Company filed a Petition to Further Suspend Local Number Portability Implementation Date.
2. On October 29, 2004, WWC Holding Company, Inc., filed a Response in Opposition to the Petition.
3. At the Commission's Weekly Meeting held on November 3, 2004, the matter was referred to an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). The undersigned ALJ received the assignment on November 5, 2004.
4. The parties will be required to submit to the Commission in writing their available dates during the months of December 2004 and January 2005 in order to set this matter for hearing. The parties will also be required to develop a procedural schedule which is agreeable to the parties and submit same in writing to the Commission.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. South Park Telephone Company and WWC Holding Company, Inc., shall within ten days of the mailing date of this Order submit available dates for hearing of this matter during the months of December 2004 and January 2005. The parties shall also confer to develop a mutually acceptable procedural schedule.
