The suspended portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 191 reads as follows:

Transportation of passengers:

- I. In call-and-demand limousine service, between all points in the County of Boulder, State of Colorado, and between said points, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- II. In call-and-demand limousine service, between all points within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Arapahoe Avenue and 28th Street in Boulder, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- III. In scheduled service, between points within Louisville, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- IV. In scheduled service, between points within Lafayette, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- V. In scheduled service, between points within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Arapahoe Avenue and 28th Street in Boulder, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- VI: In scheduled service, between all points within Longmont, Colorado and all points within one-half mile of the intersection of Interstate 25 and Colorado Highway 119, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.

Restriction (A) Item I of this Certificate is restricted against providing call-and-demand limousine service, between all points located within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Arapahoe Avenue and 28th Street in Boulder, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.

Restriction (B) Items I, III, and IV of this Certificate are restricted to the use of vehicles with a passenger capacity of not less than nine passengers, including the driver, nor more than 12 passengers, excluding the driver.
