I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. On November 25, 2019, Colorado Cab Company LLC, doing business as Denver Yellow Cab &/or Boulder Yellow Cab &/or Boulder SuperShuttle &/or Boulder Express Shuttle &/or Boulder Airporter &/ or zTrip Boulder (Applicant), filed an Application to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 191.

2. The Commission noticed this Application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on November 25, 2019, for a period of ten days.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. Pursuant to Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, we find that the information submitted with this Application warrants the granting of the requested abandonment.

5. Therefore, we conclude that the Application to abandon CPCN PUC No. 191 is in the public interest and will be granted.

II. ORDER**A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. This Application was deemed complete on December 11, 2019, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
2. The Application filed by Colorado Cab Company LLC, doing business as Denver Yellow Cab &/or Boulder Yellow Cab &/or Boulder SuperShuttle &/or Boulder Express Shuttle &/or Boulder Airporter &/ or zTrip Boulder, for approval to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 191 is granted.
3. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 191 is CANCELED.
4. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
5. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
