1. The amendment to paragraph 4 on page 1 of the Errata Notice reads as:

On October 2, 2019, the City passed Ordinance No. 2019-06, granting Black Hills Electric a franchise to provide electric service within Cripple Creek for ten years, taking effect February 1, 2020 and terminating February 1, 2029.

That paragraph states that the franchise is to terminate on "February 1, 2029." That date is incorrect. The franchise is to last for ten years. The correct date is February 1, 2030. The paragraph shall be amended to read as follows:

On October 2, 2019, the City passed Ordinance No. 2019-06, granting Black Hills Electric a franchise to provide electric service within Cripple Creek for ten years, taking effect February 1, 2020 and terminating February 1, 2030.

2. The amendment to ordering paragraph 3 on page 2 of the Errata Notice reads as:

The franchise agreement between Black Hills Electric and the City of Cripple Creek and the rights and obligations associated therewith are scheduled to expire on February 1, 2029.

That paragraph states that the franchise is scheduled to expire on "February 1, 2029." That date is incorrect. The franchise is scheduled to expire in ten years. The correct date is February 1, 2030. That paragraph shall be amended to read as follows:

The franchise agreement between Black Hills Electric and the City of Cripple Creek and the rights and obligations associated therewith are scheduled to expire on February 1, 2030.
