I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. On December 17, 2019, Victor Transportation LLC (Applicant) filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9914.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on December 30, 2019, for a period of ten days.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. Applicant requests the suspension of Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9914 pursuant to Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6. However, Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9914 was properly revoked by Decision No. R19-1018, mailed on December 18, 2019, in Proceeding No. 19C-0658-INS for Applicant's failure to keep currently effective proof of financial

responsibility on file with the Commission. Therefore, this application to suspend is moot and will be denied.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. This application was deemed complete on January 22, 2020, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The application filed by Victor Transportation LLC on December 17, 2019, for authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9914 is denied as moot.
- 3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
 - 4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
