I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. On January 6, 2020, DJTurman Enterprises LLC, doing business as Old Town Tours/Shuttle Services, filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under its authority, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55908, from December 1, 2019 through May 1, 2020.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on January 13, 2020, for a period of ten days.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. In accordance with Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, the information submitted with this application warrants the granting of a suspension of operations.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55908 is in the public interest and will be granted.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. This application was deemed complete on January 29, 2020, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The application filed by DJTurman Enterprises LLC, doing business as Old Town Tours/Shuttle Services, for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55908 is granted, *nunc pro tunc*, from December 1, 2019 through May 1, 2020.
 - 3. On May 2, 2020, CPCN PUC No. 55908 shall be administratively reactivated.
- 4. Prior to commencing operations, DJTurman Enterprises LLC, doing business as Old Town Tours/Shuttle Services, shall: (a) cause proof of insurance or surety bond coverage to be filed with the Commission pursuant to Rule 6008, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6; (b) pay to the Commission the applicable vehicle identification fee for each vehicle to be operated under authority granted by the Commission; and, (c) ensure that an effective tariff is on file with the Commission, in compliance with applicable Commission rules.
- 5. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
 - 6. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
