I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion) filed by the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and Douglas County (collectively Applicants) on March 26, 2020, seeking an extension of time of 90 days to June 1, 2020 to file the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement for this project.

2. As grounds for its Motion, the Applicants state that a three-party Construction and Maintenance Agreement has been circulated among CDOT, Douglas County, and BNSF Railway Company and is in final review at this time. The Applicants anticipate completion of the signed agreement by June 1, 2020.

3. No responses were filed to the Motion.

4. Now being fully advised in the matter, we grant the Motion.

II. **ORDER**

A. **The Commission Orders That:**

1. The Motion for Extension of Time filed by the Colorado Department of Transportation and Douglas County (collectively Applicants) on March 26, 2020, seeking an extension of time of 90 days to June 1, 2020 to file the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement for this project is granted.

2. The Applicants shall provide the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement by June 1, 2020.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction to enter further decisions as necessary.
