### ADVANCED GRID RIDER

### APPLICABILITY

All rate schedules for electric service are subject to an Advanced Grid Rider (AGR) designed to collect the costs of AGIS Projects, as defined herein, that are not being recovered through the Company's base rates. The AGR amount will be subject to annual changes to be effective on January 1 of each Year.

### DEFINITIONS

### Advanced Grid Intelligence and Security (AGIS) Initiative

A long-term strategic initiative to enhance the security, efficiency, and reliability of the distribution grid, and to enable improved customer products and services.

### **AGIS Projects**

The combination of system enhancement, both distribution and information technology and customer application projects, that are part of the initial AGIS Initiative implementation.

### Advanced Grid Rider (AGR)

The AGR is equal to the AGR Cost, minus the Projects Base Amount, plus or minus the AGR True-Up Amount, charged on a dollar per Kilowatt basis for rate schedules with Demand rates and on a dollar per Kilowatt-Hour basis for rate schedules without Demand rates as follows:

$$AGR = A - B \pm C$$

Where:

A = AGR Cost

B = Projects Base Amount

C = AGR True-up Amount

### AGR Actual Revenue Requirement (ARR)

The actual AGR revenue requirement for the previous calendar Year.

### AGR Cost (or Revenue Requirement)

For the purpose of this tariff, the AGR Cost is defined as (1) a return, equal to the Company's projected weighted average cost of capital (WACC), on the projected increase in the retail jurisdictional portion of the thirteen (13) Month average net plant in-service balances associated with the AGIS Projects for the following calendar Year in which the AGR will be in effect, exclusive of all plant in-service included in the determination of the revenue requirement underlying the Company's effective base rates. Net plant is gross plant less accumulated depreciation plus accumulated deferred income taxes; (2) the plant-related ownership costs associated with such incremental plant investment, including depreciation, income taxes, and shared asset credits; (3) the projected incremental Operations and Maintenance (O&M) expenses

above the amount currently reflected in base rates related to the AGIS Projects for the following calendar Year in which the AGR will be in effect; (4) inclusion of a regulatory asset in rate base for the undepreciated value of meters replaced by AMI meters and an amortization over the remaining life of the meters beginning in 2025; and
