## COMMISSION DECISION GRANTING SECOND REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

## I. BY THE COMMISSION

### A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a filing submitted on August 7, 2020, by Pedal the Peaks Durango LLC (Applicant), requesting that the Commission grant another 60-day extension to comply with the terms of Decision No. R20-0205 (Decision).
- 2. On January 23, 2020, Applicant filed an application for new permanent authority to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle for hire.
- 3. The Commission noticed the application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on January 27, 2020. An intervention was filed and the proceeding was referred to an Administrative Law Judge.
- 4. On March 30, 2020, the Decision was issued, granting the application as amended. In Ordering Paragraph No. 4, the Decision set forth certain requirements, such as filing proof of insurance and paying the motor vehicle fee, that were to be completed within

60 days of the Decision's effective date. However, the Decision also states that for good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of the Decision.

- 5. By Decision No. C20-0426, mailed on June 8, 2020, the Commission granted Applicant's first request for additional time and gave Applicant until August 17, 2020 to complete the requirements set forth in the Decision.
- 6. In this second request for additional time, Applicant alludes to the current COVID-19 pandemic by explaining: "We are hoping in this weird time we can have a little more time to shop around, and we've also been extremely busy in light of being an essential business in this time and that has made this even a bit more challenging."
- 7. The Commission concludes that good cause exists to extend the time for compliance with the requirements of the Decision for an additional 60 days.

### II. ORDER

#### A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The request of Pedal the Peaks Durango LLC, filed on August 7, 2020, that the Commission grant another 60-day extension for it to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R20-0205 is granted.
- 2. Pedal the Peaks Durango LLC is granted an extension of 60 days from the Mailed Date of this Decision to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R20-0205.
- 3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
  - 4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
