I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

- A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions
- 1. On November 3, 2020, DWS Transportation LLC, doing business as D W S Coach (Applicant), filed an application to abandon Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55828.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on November 9, 2020, for a period of ten days.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. Applicant requests approval to abandon CPCN PUC No. 55828, pursuant to Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6. However, CPCN PUC No. 55828 was properly revoked by Decision No. R20-0600, mailed on August 18, 2020, in Proceeding No. 20C-0303-INS, for Applicant's failure to keep currently

effective proof of financial responsibility on file with the Commission. Therefore, this application to abandon is most and will be denied.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. This application was deemed complete on November 25, 2020, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The application filed by DWS Transportation LLC, doing business as DWS Coach, for authority to abandon Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55828 is denied as moot.
- 3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
 - 4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
