**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions**

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a filing submitted on December 9, 2020, by Get2Vail Corp (Applicant), requesting that the Commission grant an additional 30 days to comply with the terms of Decision No. C20-0727 (Decision).

2. On August 21, 2020, Applicant filed an application for permanent authority to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle for hire.

3. The Commission noticed the application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on August 31, 2020. This proceeding was uncontested; and thus, it was determined without a hearing.

4. On October 12, 2020, the Commission issued the Decision and granted the permanent authority subject to conditions. For instance, Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of the Decision set forth certain requirements, such as filing proof of insurance and a tariff, that were to be completed within 60 days of the Decision's effective date. However, the Decision also states that

for good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of the Decision.

5. The Decision became effective on October 12, 2020. Hence, Applicant had until December 11, 2020 to comply with the Decision or file a request for additional time.

6. The instant request for additional time was timely filed on December 9, 2020. It explains: “Due to the pandemic situation in the country, this type of business will not be able to operate for at least for another month or so.”

7. The Commission concludes that good cause exists to extend the time for compliance with the requirements of the Decision for an additional 30 days.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. The request of Get2Vail Corp, filed on December 9, 2020, that the Commission grant an additional 30 days for it to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. C20-0727 is granted.

2. Get2Vail Corp is granted 30 days from the Mailed Date of this Decision to comply with the requirements set forth in Decision No. C20-0727.

3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.

4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
