I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. On February 25, 2021, Kids Wheels, LLC filed an application requesting the Commission authorize the suspension of Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9848 from January 21, 2021 through January 20, 2022.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on March 1, 2021, for a period of ten days.
- 3. The notice period expired on March 11, 2021. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is therefore uncontested and under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. In accordance with Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-6, the Commission finds that the information submitted by Kids Wheels, LLC with this application warrants the granting of a suspension of operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9848.

5. The Commission also finds that the application for authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9848 is in the public interest and will be granted.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. This application was deemed complete on March 17, 2021, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The application filed by Kids Wheels, LLC for authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9848 is granted from January 21, 2021 through January 20, 2022.
- 3. On January 21, 2022, Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9848 shall be administratively reactivated.
- 4. Prior to commencing operations, Kids Wheels, LLC shall: (a) cause proof of insurance or surety bond coverage to be filed with the Commission pursuant to Rule 6008, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6; (b) pay to the Commission the applicable vehicle identification fee for each vehicle to be operated under authority granted by the Commission; and, (c) ensure that an effective tariff is on file with the Commission, in compliance with applicable Commission rules.
- 5. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
