In support of this Petition, Public Service respectfully states the following:

- 1. The Company believes good cause exists to grant the waivers and relief requested in this Petition. The Company will be releasing a new My Account and mobile application from January 14 through 21, 2022 that will include (1) enhancements in design improvements in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, as well as a more modern design, a mobile-first design, a design that is consistent whether working on the desktop website My Account or mobile website

 MyAccount, (2) increases in the speed of use of the My Account and mobile application, and (3) additional integration of the My Account and mobile application with other new

 Xcel Energy programs available within the My Account experiences. During the Waiver Period, multiple self-service payment channels may become unavailable due to internal outages of systems associated with the updates to the My Account and the mobile application.
- 2. Therefore, the Company is requesting a waiver from collecting late payment charges from all customers and classes subject to late payment charges during the Waiver Period.
- 3. Public Service requests the following temporary and partial variances during the Waiver Period from the following Electric Tariff Sheets:
