I. **BY THE COMMISSION**

> Α. Statement

1. Black Hills Electric, LLC ("Black Hills") filed its Second Motion for Extension of

Time for Black Hills Colorado Electric LLC to File a Performance Incentive Mechanism, Request

for Clarification, and Motion for Shortened Response Time on July 22, 2024. The Motion seeks

an extension of time for the utility to file various proposals for a performance incentive mechanism

("PIM"). Currently, the proposals are due August 1, 2024. Black Hills indicates that most of the

parties to the proceeding do not oppose its request for shortened response time, but that two parties

had not yet responded to its request. Black Hills requests that the response time to the Motion be

shortened to July 29, 2024.

2. We find good cause to shorten the response time to the Motion. The Motion is

largely unopposed, and a July 29, 2024 response deadline strikes an appropriate balance between

allowing the parties an opportunity to respond and allowing the Commission to take up the merits of the Motion prior to the expiration of the current PIM deadline.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The responses to the Motion discussed above are due July 29, 2024.
- 2. The 20-day period provided for in § 40-6-114, C.R.S., within which to file an Application for Rehearing, Reargument, or Reconsideration, begins on the first day following the effective date of this Decision.
 - 3. This Decision is effective upon its Issued Date.
