I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

- 1. On December 20, 2024, Petitioner Bull Dog Recovery ("Petitioner") filed a Petition to reverse an initial determination of driver disqualification pursuant to § 40-10.1-401(2)(b), C.R.S.
- 2. On January 8, 2025, the matter was referred by minute entry to an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for disposition during the Commission's Weekly Meeting.
- 3. On January 8, 2025, Trial Staff of the Public Utility Commission ("Trial Staff") filed its Notice of Intervention as of Right, Entry of Appearance and Notice Pursuant to rule 1007(a) and Rule 1401, and Request for Hearing.
- 4. On January 22, 2025, by Decision No. R25-0047-I, the parties were ordered to file an update on open court cases concerning the Petitioner. The filing was required to be made by March 7, 2025.
- 5. On March 7, 2025, Staff made a filing updating the open court cases involving the Petitioner. The Petitioner did not make the ordered filing.

II. PREHERARING CONFERENCE

> 6. In examining the filing made by Staff, while it appears there is not a resolution in

all the open cases, in order to move the proceeding forward, a prehearing conference shall be

scheduled.

7. At the prehearing conference the parties should be prepared to discuss procedures

and a date for an evidentiary hearing.

8. It is noted that the Petitioner failed to make the ordered filing on March 7, 2025.

Failure to appear for the prehearing conference shall lead to dismissal of the petition.
