ANSWER TESTIMONY OF RON D. VELARDE

- 1 Q. Please state your name and address.
- 2 A. My name is Ron D. Velarde and my address is 423 W. Mayfield Dr., Grand
- 3 Junction, CO 81507.
- 4 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?
- 5 A. My testimony presents our continued concerns as property owners in the proposed
- 6 right of way that Tri-State proposed to build on or near our property on Pass
- 7 Creek Road within both Huerfano and Costilla Counties.
- 8 Q. Why is such a power line of concern?

- 1 A. My concern is because of the lay of the land. Our property lies between the 2 altitudes of 9,200-9,000 feet. In addition, our land receives a lot of moisture 3 especially between the months of July through November and March through 4 June. The electro-magnetic electricity and noise levels are at its greatest at this 5 altitude and because of the moisture we receive at this location. This EME is of 6 grave concern to me and my family who are in this vicinity during those periods 7 of time. The P.U.C. should protect us from this type of potential health risk, noise 8 and other types of problems that can arise at this altitude.
- 9 Q. What do you do for a living?
- I have worked for the Colorado Division of Wildlife for 39 years. Although I am presently an administrator stationed in Grand Junction, I am a Wildlife Biologist by trade and very familiar with the eco- system in and around the LaVeta Pass area.
- Q. Are there any residences on the property, and if so, are they within the proposed corridor for the transmission line?
- 16 A. Yes, we have two residences within the proposed transmission line. One belongs
 17 to my uncle's family and the other belongs to my brother Anthony Velarde and
 18 me.
- Q. Do you think that Tri-State and Public Service have demonstrated their need for this line sufficiently to warrant impacts it might have on your property and other similar properties?
- A. No, I have not seen the need explained to me other than the need to prevent power outages in the San Luis Valley and to carry power generated from

- proposed solar from the San Luis Valley to the front range. They have not
- 2 explained very well why the power shouldn't be carried in the existing corridor
- 3 from Alamosa over Poncha Pass.
