The principal proposed change is: to modify the Interim Renewable Energy Standard Adjustment (RESA) by renaming it as the Renewable Energy Standard Adjustment and increasing the RESA. The Company files this proposed tariff sheet to be effective January 1, 2008. This increased rate is authorized by C.R.S. §40-2-124(1)(g)(I).

The RESA will be increased so that it is a two percent (2.0%) adjustment applicable to each customer's total electric bill, including base rates and all adjustments. The effect of this filing on the Company's annual revenue will be an increase of approximately \$33 million based on the Company's estimated revenue for the twelve (12) months ending December 31, 2008. The revenues received from the RESA will be accounted for by the Company in a separate account and used only to support acquisition of Eligible Energy to meet the mandates of

C.R.S. §40-2-124. The level and structure of the RESA are consistent with C.R.S. §40-2-124(1)(g)(I).

The impact of this filing on the Company's customers is an increase of 1.4% on each customer's total electric bill. For an average residential customer, the monthly electric bill increase is \$0.79 based on total rates effective October 1, 2007. For an average small commercial customer, the monthly electric bill increase is \$1.27.

It is desired that the changed tariffs accompanying this advice letter become effective January 1, 2008.
