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The purpose of this filing is to revise the Company's tariff to propose base rates for all rate schedules, to cancel several rate schedules, and add a section for transportation terms and conditions related to the Company's Phase I Rate Case in Docket No. 08S-290G. This Advice Letter constitutes a Phase II Rate Case. Tariff sheets filed in this Advice Letter are meant to supersede those filed with Advice Letter 528 and would cancel all tariff sheets filed with Advice Letter 528.

The proposed rates are designed to produce annual revenue of \$80,002,518. The increase in revenue requirement of \$2,696,005 is the same as the increase proposed in the tariff sheets filed with Advice Letter 528. In this Phase II filing, the Company is redesigning its rates based on usage level rather than type of service to include small commercial, small volume, and large volume rate schedules, replacing the existing rate schedules. The Company is also proposing transportation rate schedules that are comparable to the corresponding sales rate schedule along with a new section of transportation terms and conditions. The Company is also proposing therm billing and a standard pressure of 14.73psi.

The table below shows the impact to customers. The table shows the proposed rate classes. The current average monthly bill is the weighted average for customers assigned to the raw rate classes.

Filed with this advice letter is testimony and exhibits that support the Company's proposal.

Black Hills asks that the tariff sheets accompanying this advice letter become effective on sixty days' notice, or on November 18, 2008. In the event the Commission decides to set these tariffs for hearing, and to suspend their effective date, this effective date is designed to result in a total suspension period of 210-days ending on June 10, 2009. If the Commission decides to set these tariffs for hearing, Black Hills also respectfully requests that the Commission consult with Black Hills and its counsel regarding procedural dates prior to the entry of the suspension order.
