I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement

1. In accordance with Rule 6212 of the Commission's Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicles, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, each regulated intrastate carrier shall file with the Commission an annual report on or before April 30 for the preceding calendar year. Rule 6212 states that the annual report shall be submitted on a form

2. This Order specifies the form to be filed by common and contract carriers for the 2010 reporting year. The carriers shall submit their annual report in accordance with the requirements listed on Appendix A to this Order. The annual report forms may be found on the

B. Conclusion

3. We find that each common carrier authorized to provide passenger transportation under a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and each contract carrier authorized to

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provide passenger transportation under a Permit within the State of Colorado during calendar year 2010 shall file an annual report in the form prescribed here. Such reports shall be filed no later than April 30, 2011, in accordance with Rule 6212.

- 4. Each common and contract carrier is required to identify the individual authorized to file on its behalf and designated as the Annual Report Contact. We note that, in accordance with § 40-7-106, C.R.S., every officer, agent, or employee of any public utility who violates or fails to comply with, or who aids or abets any violation by any public utility of, among other things, any order, decision, or rule of this Commission, commits a Class 2 Misdemeanor and may be punished as provided in § 18-1.3-501, C.R.S.
- 5. A common or contract carrier subject to this Order may file a motion for extension of time to file its annual report, which may be granted if good cause is shown as to why it is unable to comply with the April 30, 2011 deadline. Motions for extension of time shall be referred to an Administrative Law Judge for disposition.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. On or before April 30, 2011, each common carrier authorized to provide passenger transportation under a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and each contract carrier authorized to provide passenger transportation under a Permit within the State of Colorado during calendar year 2010 shall file an annual report on the form prescribed in this Order and in accordance with the requirements listed on Appendix A to this Order.
- 2. Each common carrier and contract carrier is strongly encouraged to make its filing using the Commission's E-Filings System. To accomplish this, each common carrier and contract carrier shall have one of its designated filers submit an executable electronic copy (*e.g.*,

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Excel) of the annual report through the Commission's E-Filings system. Once in the E-Filings system, select the *document type* "Annual Report" and in the *title* field insert the common or contract carrier's name, along with; "2010 Annual Report". - 3. This matter is referred to an Administrative Law Judge for disposition of all motions and pleadings.
