**COMMISSION ORDER CONCERNING FILING
OF YEAR 2010 ANNUAL REPORTS BY
OIL PRODUCT PIPELINE COMPANIES**

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. In accordance with Rule 4006 of the Commission's Rules Regulating Gas Utilities and Pipeline Operators, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-4, each Oil Product Pipeline Company (Pipeline Company) shall file with the Commission an annual report for the preceding calendar year. The utility shall submit the annual report on forms previously mailed by the Commission; shall properly complete the forms; shall ensure the forms are verified and signed by a person authorized to act on behalf of the utility; and shall file the required number of copies pursuant to subparagraph 1204(a)(IV) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 CCR 723-1.

2. This Order specifies the form to be filed by each Pipeline Company for the 2010 reporting year. The Pipeline Company shall submit their annual report in accordance with the requirements listed on Appendix A to this Order. The annual report forms may be found on the Commission's website at:

3. All Pipeline Companies must also submit a copy of their gross regulated intrastate operating revenues report, required by the Colorado Department of Revenue as Form DR 0525. This form may be found on the Department of Revenue and the Commission's website.

B. Conclusion

4. We find that each Pipeline Company operating within the State of Colorado during calendar year 2010 shall file an annual report. Such reports shall be filed no later than April 30, 2011, in accordance with Rule 4006.

5. Each Pipeline Company is required to identify the individual authorized to file on its behalf and designated as the Annual Report Contact. We note that, in accordance with § 40-7-106, C.R.S., every officer, agent, or employee of any public utility who violates or fails to comply with, or who aids or abets any violation by any public utility of, among other things, any order, decision, or rule of this Commission, commits a Class 2 Misdemeanor and may be punished as provided in § 18-1.3-501, C.R.S.

6. A Pipeline Company subject to this Order may file a motion for extension of time to file its annual report, which may be granted if good cause is shown as to why it is unable to comply with the April 30, 2011 deadline. Such motion shall not include a request for extension of time to file Form DR 0525. Motions for extension of time shall be referred to an Administrative Law Judge for disposition.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. On or before April 30, 2011, each Oil Product Pipeline Company (Pipeline Company) operating within the State of Colorado during calendar year 2010 shall file an annual report.

2. Each Pipeline Company is strongly encouraged to make its filing using the Commission's E-Filings System. To accomplish this, each company shall have one of its designated filers submit the annual report through the Commission's E-Filings system. Once in the E-Filings system, select the *document type* "Annual Report" and in the *title* field insert the Pipeline Company's name, along with; "2010 Annual Report". 3. This matter is referred to an Administrative Law Judge for disposition of all motions and pleadings.

4. Pipeline Companies shall also submit a copy of the Colorado Department of Revenue Form DR 0525 no later than April 30, 2011. Entities may not request an extension of time to file Form DR 0525.

5. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
