**COMMISSION ORDER CONCERNING FILING
OF YEAR 2012 ANNUAL REPORTS BY
OIL PRODUCT PIPELINE COMPANIES**

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. In accordance with § 40-2-111, C.R.S., each oil product pipeline company (Pipeline Company) operating in intrastate commerce within Colorado shall file with the Commission, an annual report for the preceding calendar year. Section 40-2-111, C.R.S., states that the annual report shall be filed on forms prescribed by the Commission.

2. This Order specifies the forms to be filed by each Pipeline Company for the 2012 reporting year. Each Pipeline Company shall file its annual report in accordance with the requirements listed on Appendix A to this Order. The annual report form may be found on the Commission's website at <http://www.dora.state.co.us/puc/forms/EnergyForms/EnergyForms.htm>.

3. Each Pipeline Company operating in intrastate commerce must also file a copy of their gross regulated intrastate operating revenues report, required by the Colorado Department of Revenue as Form DR 0525. This form may also be found on the Commission's website.

B. Conclusion

4. We find that each Pipeline Company operating in intrastate commerce within the State of Colorado during calendar year 2012 shall file with the Commission the annual report, no later than April 30, 2013. Each Pipeline Company operating in intrastate commerce within the State of Colorado during calendar year 2012 shall also file a copy of Form DR 0525 with the Commission no later than April 30, 2013.

5. Each Pipeline Company is required to identify the individual authorized to file on its behalf and designated as the Annual Report Contact. If no specific designation is made to the Commission, an officer of the Pipeline Company will be considered as the Annual Report Contact. We note that, in accordance with § 40-7-106, C.R.S., every officer, agent, or employee of any public utility who violates or fails to comply with, or who aids or abets any violation by any public utility of, among other things, any order, decision, or rule of this Commission, commits a Class 2 Misdemeanor and may be subject to penalties, including without limitation, penalties set forth in § 18-1.3-501, C.R.S.

6. A Pipeline Company subject to this Order may file a motion for extension of time to file its annual report with the Commission. The motion may be granted if good cause is shown as to why the Pipeline Company is unable to comply with the April 30, 2013, deadline. Such motion shall not include a request for extension of time to file Form DR 0525. Motions for an extension of time shall be referred to an Administrative Law Judge for disposition.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. On or before April 30, 2013, each Oil Product Pipeline Company (Pipeline Company) operating in intrastate commerce within the State of Colorado during calendar year

2012 shall file with the Commission an annual report on the form prescribed in this Order, and any additional reports as required by Appendix A to this Order.

2. Each Pipeline Company shall also file a copy of the Colorado Department of Revenue Form 0525 no later than April 30, 2013. A Pipeline Company may not request an extension of time to file Form DR 0525.

3. This matter is referred to an Administrative Law Judge for disposition of all motions and pleadings.

4. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
