**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement**

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a formal adoption of ten investigation reports submitted by the metro Denver area Regional Transportation District light rail operation. The investigation reports are for seven accidents and three incidents between the dates of July 1, 2013 and September 30, 2013. A report summarizing these accidents and incidents was filed by Staff of the Public Utilities Commission (Staff) on January 9, 2014.

2. The accident and incident numbers for the seven accidents and three incidents reviewed by the Commission are:

I1-07142013, A1-07292013, I1-08062013, A1-08072013, A1-08162013,  
A1-08192013, A1-08252013, I1-09022013, A1-09262013, and A1-09272013

3. The Commission has reviewed the summary report filed by Staff and concurs with Staff's review of the investigation reports and recommendations.

4. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter under § 40-18-103, C.R.S., and Rule 7348 of the Rules Regulating Railroads, Rail Fixed Guideways, Transportation by Rail, and Rail Crossings, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-7.

## II. ORDER

### A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Commission formally adopts investigation reports I1-07142013, A1-07292013, I1-08062013, A1-08072013, A1-08162013, A1-08192013, A1-08252013, I1-09022013, A1-09262013, and A1-09272013 submitted by the metro Denver area Regional Transportation District light rail operations.
