I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Request for Extension of Time to File a Signed Copy of the Construction and Maintenance Agreement (Motion) filed by the County of Douglas (Douglas County) Engineering Services on January 3, 2014 requesting an additional 90 days to March 31, 2014 to file a copy of the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement in this matter.

2. As grounds, Douglas County states that it has provided a draft copy of a three-party agreement to BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) for review and that BNSF is awaiting information from their consultant regarding the exit gate installation. Douglas County requests an additional 90 days of time to complete and file a copy of the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement in this matter.

3. No responses were filed to the Motion.

4. Now being fully advised in the matter, we grant the Motion.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Request for Extension of Time to File a Signed Copy of the Construction and Maintenance Agreement filed by Douglas County on January 3, 2014 requesting an additional 90 days to March 31, 2014 to file the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement in this matter is granted.

2. Douglas County shall have until March 31, 2014 to file a copy of the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement in this matter.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction to enter further decisions in this matter.
